RCBH MEDICAL MALL HIRING EVENT SAN LUIS, AZ

DECEMBER 2, 2020 - The Regional Center for Border Health (RCBH) along with the help of ARIZONA@WORK- Yuma County, hosted a **50-job** hiring event for the following careers: nursing, anesthesiology, phlebotomy, surgical tech, medical coding & billing, medical records specialist, armed security, prep cook, cashier, IT specialist and front desk clerk. So far, 22 applicants have been hired with more to come after upcoming interviews!

The outdoor event was held in the Cesar Chavez Cultural Center parking lot. With social media blasts sent out in both English & Spanish, "There was no telling how many people we might get," said Moises Pimental, Business Services Consultant at ARIZONA@WORK- Yuma County. Pimental was hoping for fifty applicants and was pleasantly surprised to see such a great turnout: Nearly 200! Anticipating a large crowd, however, Pimental and his South County counterpart, Mariana Martinez,







planned very well. Applicants entered the area for free COVID-19 screening provided by the RCBH San Luis Walk-In Clinic. After waiting 10-15 minutes for nasal swab test results, applicants testing negative for the virus were escorted into the hiring event. With appropriate social distancing protocols in place, interviews were conducted on-site. Testing and interview stations were sanitized between candidates. While the wind picked up for a while, it didn't deter hopeful applicants from joining the team at a new medical mall complex located in San Luis, AZ.

The official grand opening date has not yet been released but stay tuned for more details in early 2021!
